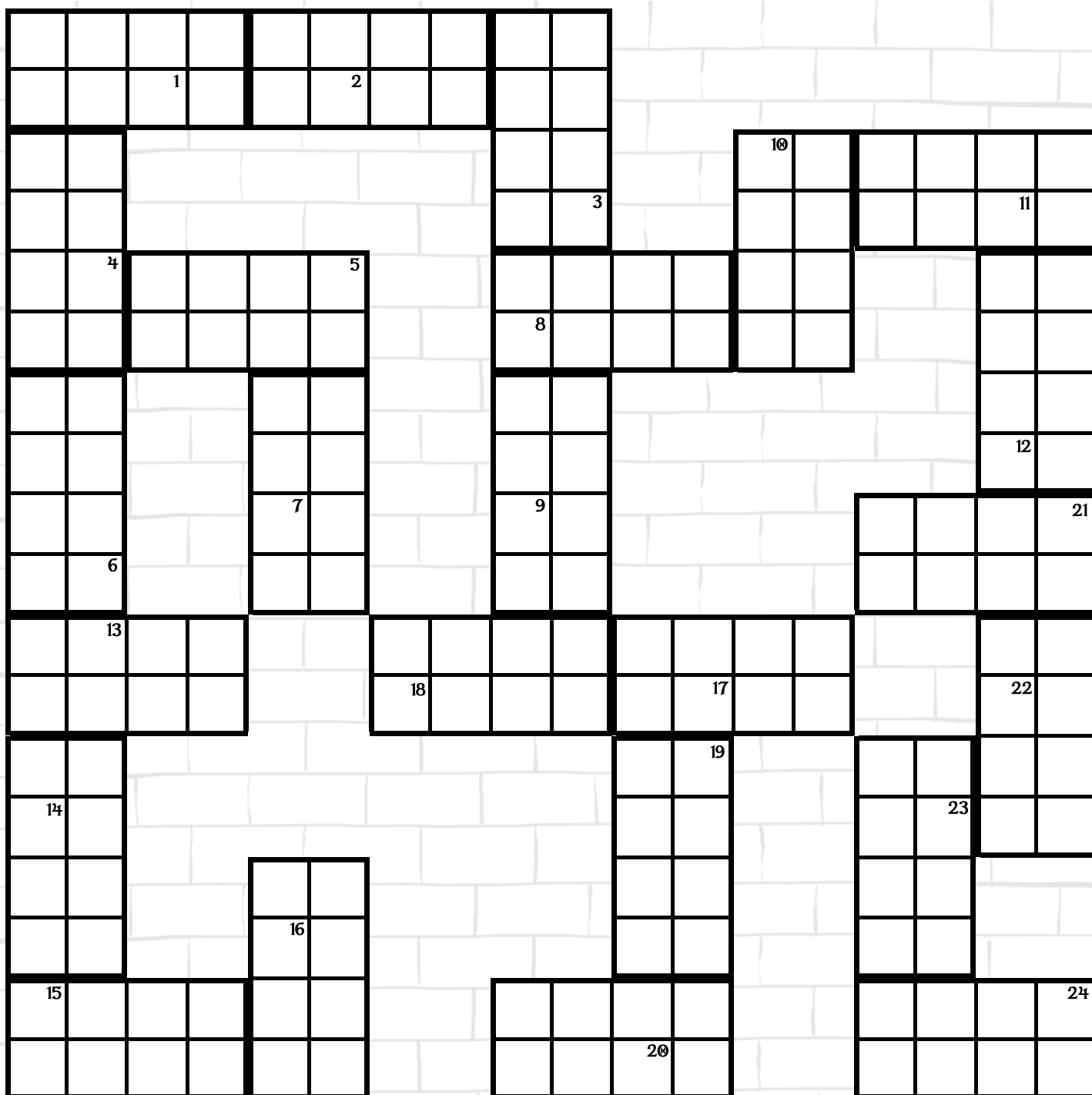


# ENTER DRAGON ALLEY

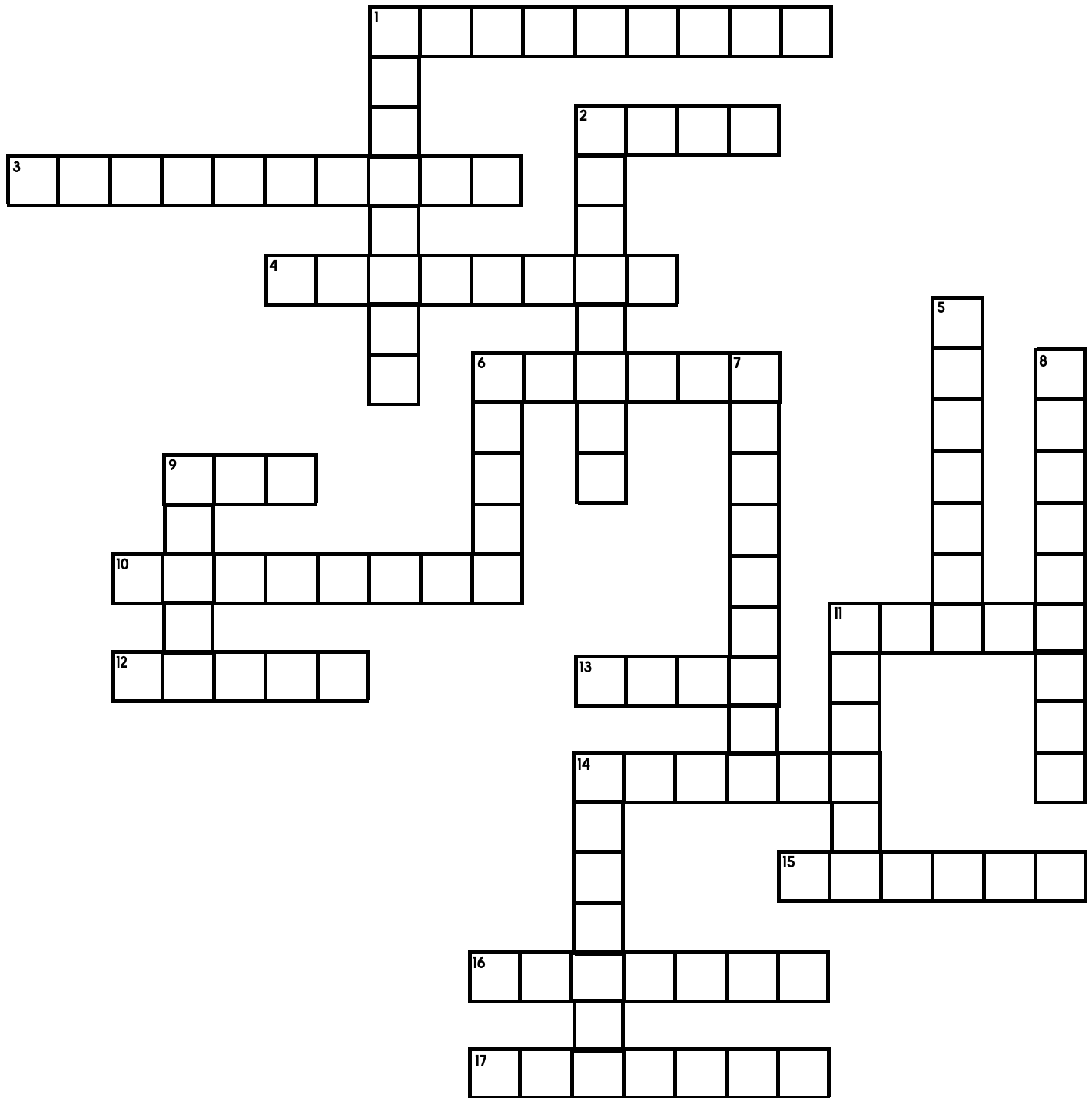

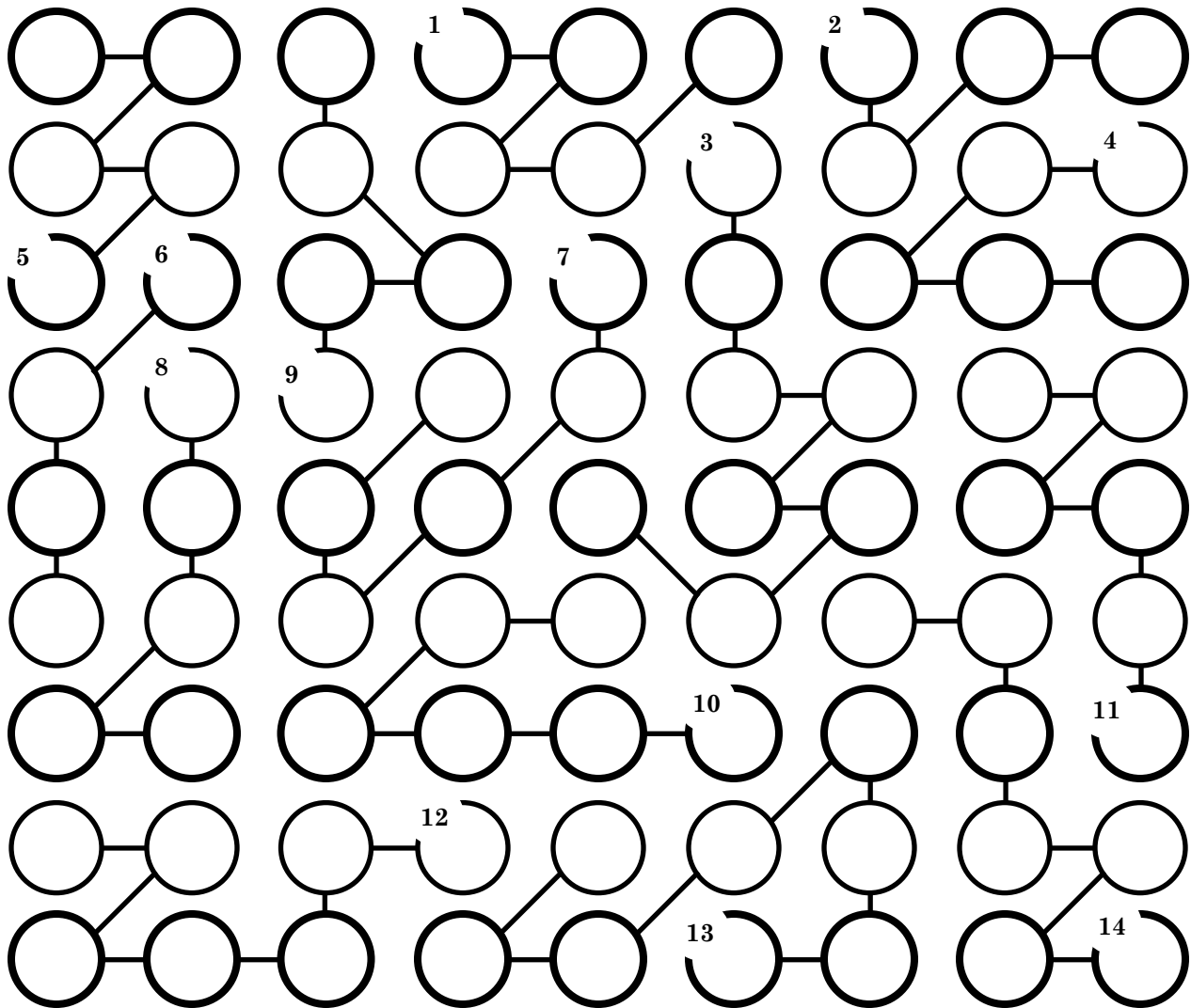
